- Consultancy work including e.g. in the fields of biogas upgrading, gas transportation, gasification, gaseous fuels, standardization etc.

Swedish strongholds

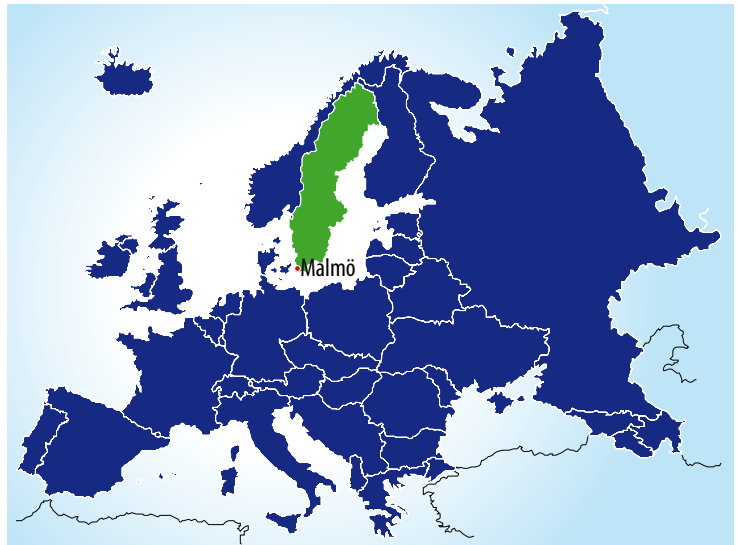
Sweden is world leading in:
